Preserve Your View

Aluminum railings have a more open concept with 2", 3" and 4" post options. You can use aluminum 3/4" square spindles and we also have cable and glass railing options for an even more open view.

Vinyl railing tends to be a bit bigger. With a standard post size of 4" and 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" vinyl rails and 1 1/4" and 1 1/2" spindle options.

Add Some Color

Vinyl railings have three color options. White, tan, and clay. All have a glossy finish. Aluminum railing has 12 colors to pick from with glossy and textured finish options. When thinking about which color is best for you, one thing to keep in mind is what will your house look like in 5-10 years? Are you going to repaint or redo your siding?

Durability that lasts

Structurally vinyl and aluminum railings are both very comparable. We use a heavy grade aluminum and our vinyl posts and rails are reinforced with aluminum to ensure you're getting a product that lasts.

Both are a maintenance free railing system. Our aluminum goes through an intense powder coating process and our vinyl is finished with a coating to help protect the surface underneath.
